

SUMMER SCREAM FAQ SHEET

1. Are campers bunked by age?
No- All girls are in the girls dormitory, all boys are in the boys dormitory bunked by group or at random.
2. What is the counselor to camper ratio?
One counselor for every ten teens.
3. Are campers always supervised?
Yes- a counselor accompanies them 24 hours a day.
4. How are the campers disciplined?
First time- warning. Second time- miss activity. Third time- sent to Camp Director. Continued disobedience may result in dismissal from camp.
5. May I call my child at camp?
Campers can receive calls only in the case of emergency. Incoming calls are discouraged out of consideration for others campers and planned activities.
6. Can I reach someone at camp any time of the day or night in case of an emergency?

7. Can campers receive mail during their stay?
Yes- if you wish to send mail to your campers while they are here, you can send it to

8. What do you do for homesick kids? Do you let them call home?
Campers are allowed to call home at the Camp Directors discretion. Campers who become homesick and leave their camp session early are not eligible for refunds.
9. Is there a nurse available at all times?
Yes- a nurse is on staff.

10. What happens if my child has a bed wetting accident?
If the child tells the counselor, staff will wash the bedding while the kids are out.
11. Do you give kids pain relievers if needed?
Yes. Designated medical professionals are available at the Nurses Station to dispense over-the-counter medication as needed.
12. Does my child have to turn in his medicine even if he knows when to take it and how much?
Campers are allowed to bring prescription medications, but these must be turned in to the counselors at check-in (this includes inhalers.)
14. How close is the nearest hospital?
4 miles.
15. Are you able to provide special dietary needs such as no sugar, no candy, no dairy, nothing with red dye in it, no fried foods, etc?
Yes- if the child is under medical supervision by a doctor or allergic reactions known. To ensure special needs are met, please call at least two weeks prior to the child's camp arrival.
16. Can kids stay an extra day or arrive one day early?
No- no exceptions.
17. Can kids pay their balance at the door?
No- the fee must be paid in full by June 1st.
18. What denomination is Summer Scream?
Non- denominational.
19. Do you make kids speak in other tongues if they don't want to?
No.
21. Can adult sponsors bunk with kids?
No.

21. What are specific activities the campers will be doing?
Campers will be attending services, swimming, doing organized game activities, paddle boating, water slide and water trampoline.

22. What do the kids do if it rains?
Play games indoors with their team leaders.

23. If my child has to come home early, is there a partial refund?
No- In the cases of dismissal due to continued behavioral problems or homesickness, camp fees will not be refunded. The camp will not be held responsible for travel expenses incurred in picking up the child.

24. How many times a day do you have services?
We will have services twice a day.

25. Is the 50 dollar deposit ever refundable?
No- The 50 dollar deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable.
